

Pursuing D. Ed. Min. from the Southern Seminary

I believe that Christian education and theological education can be a means to establish gospel communities in closed communities in Nepal. We want to reach the next generation with Christian education and empower the local churches with theological Education.

I would like to see 1,500 primary schools started, 400 churches planted, and a theological training center running during our life time.

I have been involved in ministry since my conversion. This had forced me to learn and lead. I have observed three huge obstacles to establishing gospel communities in the rural areas of Nepal since they are typically mono-ethnic people groups, and they live in closed communities. Three big obstacles are: persecution, lack of education, and lack of jobs. Christian schools bring answers for all three challenges. Having a D. Ed. Min. will add skills and credibility to this ministry.

My family is going back to Nepal as missionaries of Reaching and Teaching International Ministry. It is a 501(c)3 organization.
